Children from across the school worked together to create a large art piece which was inspired by one of the stained glass windows from the church. Everyone was so impressed with how fantastic and detailed the children's artwork was! It was nice to hear comments from families and members of the public about how impressed they were with the children's art exhibit—well done children! We have had some really exciting changes over the summer break, with the addition of our brand new school library! This week, we have had the official opening of the library and we also invited Helen Stewart a local Storyteller to come along as part of this event and spend time with each of our classes telling them different stories. It started with the whole school coming together to listen to Helen telling us a story which involved us all getting involved—even the grown-ups too!

We will be sending out our new format 'Parental Curriculum Overviews' this week which give a clear overview of the curriculum coverage across the Autumn Term.
