PE Sports Premium – 2016-2017 Projection

In the academic year of 2015-2016, the school received £8841 from the government to raise standards of teaching and learning in PE for all children at the school. The aim now is that by building children's physical skills, social skills, personal skills, creativity, cognitive skills and health and fitness, then this will then raise academic and behaviour standards throughout the school. The school day must now be much more active with PE and school sport helping to raise standards in Maths and English particularly. Teachers should be upskilled rather than relying on sports coaches.

This funding is set to be doubled next year as long as there is no general election. This shows the importance of PE and school sport at the moment. It is a main focus of Ofsted inspections.
