**26<sup>th</sup> May:** School closes for half term

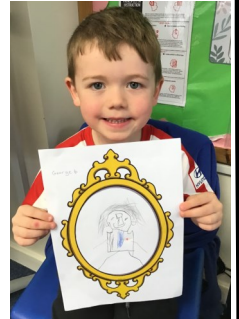
**12th June:** School re-opens for the second half of the summer term.
