Reception (Red certificate)

• I can help my teacher with Collective Worship

Year 1 (Yellow certificate)

As for Reception and:

- I can prepare the worship table (i.e. set out candles, Bible, values poster, worship colour).
- I can plan with others and help to lead an act of worship for my class.

Year 2 (Pink certificate)

As for Year 1 and:

- I can prepare the worship table.
- I can plan with others and help to lead an act of worship for my class.
- I can talk about why Christians celebrate Christmas, Easter and Pentecost. (i.e. the stories that lie behind the festivals).
- I can say the Lord's Prayer and talk about the meaning of some parts of it.

Year 3 (Green certificate)

As for Year 2 and:

• I can plan and lead, with a small group of others, an act of worship for the class or KS2 which includes the four elements of CW (Gather, Welcome – Listen, Respond – Go Forth, Learn – Reflect, Respond).

Year 4 (Orange certificate)

As for Year 3 and:

- I can evaluate an act of worship led by others using the school evaluation proforma and feedback constructively, suggesting improvements where appropriate.
- I can find passages from a Bible that we are using as the root of our worship (using the contents page).
- I can create a prayer or reflection station with others which can be used in our school building or as part of our prayer spaces.

Year 5 (Purple certificate)

As for Year 4 and:

I can plan

- and lead each element in a whole act of worship independently, working with others to produce any drama, PowerPoints or visual aids needed, as well as sourcing all resources or artefacts.
- I can design a template to evaluate the impact of worship and use it to evaluate the worship I have planned and led.

Year 6 (Blue Certificate)

As for Year 5 and:

- I can talk about some of the symbols used in worship and in particular how symbols can help our understanding of God as Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- I can describe how the Bible is made up of different types of writing and say which books make up the New Testament.
- I can also confidently find passages in the New Testament (using the Contents page) that are being used in worship.
- I can explain the cycle of the Church calendar and the reasons Harvest, Christmas, Easter, Pentecost, Epiphany, Candlemas and Trinity are marked in special ways.
