
Keeping Healthy: Children in Year 3 and Reception will be given Toothpaste and toothbrush before the end of term. Warrington Oral Health Promotions Team are currently working with the Primary Schools in Warrington to set up a Toothpaste and Toothbrush distribution scheme. The main focus will be promoting the use of family fluoride toothpaste amongst young children as there is clear evidence to support the effectiveness of fluoride in reducing dental decay.



Keeping our Children Safe:



Before we break up for summer we are doing some workshops within in school with the children on how to keep themselves safe. We have invited in PC Kelly Meredith who will be working predominantly with KS2 on stranger danger, safety, anti-social behaviour including fire and drug safety. We are being proactive in response to a meeting held with the local PCSOs where they have informed us of various anti-social activities which have been reported in the area. It is our priority to ensure the safety of our children while they are in school but also during holidays and weekends.
