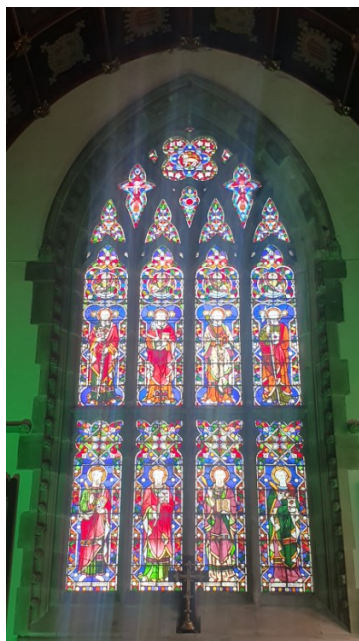

"I liked to go to the church because I think it's nice and peaceful a lot of the time and the drawing was quite interesting; I tried my best with my drawings.



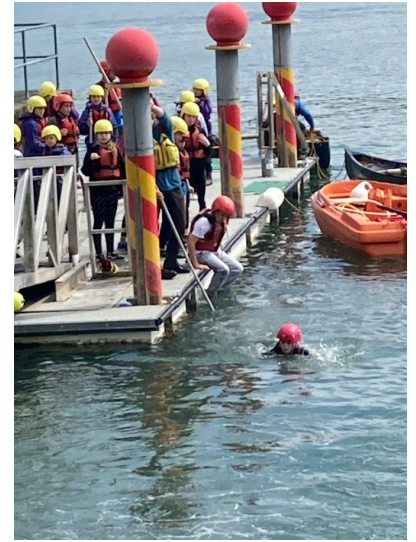
