CONSULTATION ON SCHOOL ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS 2027-28

As a voluntary aided Church of England primary school, the governing body is the admissions authority and is responsible for determining our admissions arrangements. We are required to consult on any proposed changes to our admissions policy, and we are now seeking your views on our proposed admissions arrangements for 2027/28. We are proposing:

- **Change to our Admissions Criteria** to move siblings to position 3 on the list from position 4, meaning 'faith based—regular attendance at St Oswald's, Winwick', would move from position 3 to position 4.

We welcome your views on these proposed arrangements. **Please submit your responses by 28th January 2026.** You can respond by:

Following the consultation period, the governing body will:

- Carefully consider all responses received
- Make a final decision on the admissions arrangements
- Publish the determined admissions policy by 28th February 2026
- Notify all consultees of the outcome
