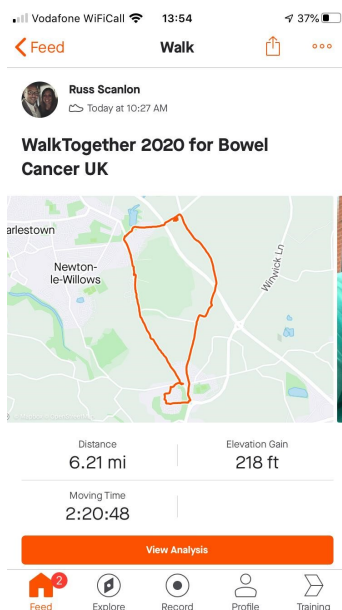

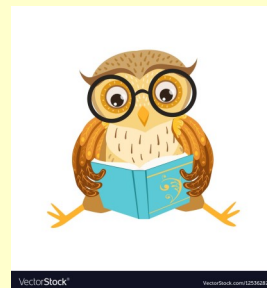

IMPORTANT WEEKLY UPDATES AND INFORMATION

RISE IN CV19 CASES IN ST HELENS & WARRINGTON: Due to the rise in numbers in our locality please ensure you maintain a 2metre distance when dropping off and picking up.
