This week we have welcomed our advisors from both the Local Authority and Liverpool Diocese into our school, who were both so impressed with the behaviour of the children, their attitudes to learning and our positive learning environments. It has been wonderful to see the development of children's learning in classes, including on their classroom Working Walls, which support the children in their lessons. You can see some examples in 'Our Learning This Week...' Our Reception children are doing a super job with their Phonics and practising their letter formation... *"My 't's' are so good, come and look!"* Our Year 1 children are doing well with their transition into Year 1, and are enjoying the opportunities to explore their learning challenges in their continuous provision areas... *"I think I can count all of these cubes but I bet there is more than a hundred because just look at them (holds up the jar)!"* Our Year 2 children have continued their learning in History about the Titanic... *"I am working on my History about the Titanic because in class we have been learning about it with Miss Codd."* Our Year 3 children have been working on their partitioning in Maths... *"I think I might get a Headteacher's Award this week because I have worked sooooo hard with Maths!"* Our Year 4 children have started their swimming lessons... *"Swimming was AMAZING!!!"* Our Year 5 children have been exploring their vehicle text in English—'Henry's Freedom Box'... *"I feel so sad for Henry and what he had to go through. I hope he has a happy ending in his life—I really do!"* Our Year 6 children have really impressed Mrs Mather with the contributions the children have been making in their English lessons... *"I have been so impressed with the quality of discussion surrounding our model text—'Chance Encounter' - the children have been so reflective; I can't wait to read their work!" (Mrs Mather).* We have also welcome Mrs Adams (Headteacher) and Mr Robinson from Hope Academy and two of our past pupils who spoke with parents and children in our Year 5/6 classes.
