

## Year 5 Spelling Overview – Autumn 1 2019

Spelling lists are based on the key spelling rules and patterns that children need to spell accurately to enable them to reach their age-related expectations at the end of Year 5. Spelling lists are given out at the beginning of each half term and copies can be found on School PING and on the class page of the school website. The table below shows you which week the children should be learning which set of spellings. Spellings will usually be tested on a **FRIDAY**.

In addition to these, the children will also be working on the Y5/6 Common Exception Word List and any words that they are still unable to spell on the Y1/2/3/4 Common Exception Word List. These may sometimes form part of the weekly spelling lists, but will also be covered as part of the children's work in class and may sometimes be sent home linked to children's English homework too.

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Spelling Test Scores will be recorded in the children's Homework Diaries each week.
