Clubs finish at 4pm with children being collected from the front exit at the Key Stage 2 end of the building, closest to the shop.

Please note, there is no charge for booster sessions. **Warrington Wolves sessions are run for specific groups within school, children will be invited to sessions linked to this. *** Guitar and Keyboard Tuition are run by external providers. For more information, please contact our school office.

Across the academic year, we will be providing opportunities for the range of clubs to be covered; for some of these this will mean alternating year groups for some clubs (e.g. art/cookery/ Eco offer will rotate cohorts across the academic year to ensure all classes have been given this option by the end of the year). To enable us to provide a wider offer across the year, you will notice that our **school-run clubs finish at 4pm**, this enables us to utilise a larger number of our staff team to provide this offer for you. As always, places are limited on each club, but because of the way we have organised our clubs this year, there are more places across a range of clubs for each year group across the year than in previous years.

As we move into the Spring/Summer Terms, there will be a wider offer for Sport; in moving into the winter months, Sports Clubs need access to the hall and we are limited to it's use on specific days, whereas in warmer months we can access outdoor spaces for sports too.

HOW DO I BOOK CLUBS FOR MY CHILD?

- Booking for Clubs for Spring 2 will open on Wednesday 20th December from 1pm. All school clubs are bookable/payable via ParentPay with the exception of External Provider Clubs whose information has been sent out separately. Please ensure you follow through to the payment section to book and pay for clubs to ensure the place is secured.
 REMEMBER TO USE THE 'BOOK SESSIONS' BUTTON; this will then bring up the option to 'CONFIRM BOOKINGS', which will show the number of sessions and the total cost for the club. Once you have done this, press 'CONFIRM' to secure your booking.
- If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium, and you wish to include this as part of our Pupil Premium Offer, please contact our school office who can arrange this for you.
- If your child is booked in for Link Club but you are booking an enrichment club for the same day, please book and pay for the enrichment club as normal. If you have signed your child up to both an enrichment club and Link Club, please email the school office to notify them of the clubs that you have booked (including the days) for each child. A refund for the enrichment club will then be arranged once the duration of the club finishes (e.g. Autumn 1 would be refunded Autumn 2). For cookery, there will still be the additional ingredient cost.
