It has been our History focus week this week, with the high point being our Historical Costume day on Wednesday. We had Evacuees, Vikings, Romans, Cavemen as well as outfits from the Edwardian times (Titanic) and also from a more modern Britain! Our teachers also got involved too! At the end of the day, the children came together in the hall to do a History Showcase where children from each class shared with the school what they have been learning about in their History units and Mr Henaghen helped them create a human timeline showing where the different events sat next to each other on the historical timeline! You can see some photographs in our learning this week section of the newsletter. Here are some of the children's reflections...

RECEPTION

We stood in a line and Miss Platt asked us to stand in our birthdays and be in an order. But I couldn't remember mine but it was okay because Miss Platt had a list!

YEAR 1

I have been enjoying learning about what old teddy bears use to be like. So, the older ones have longer noses and the older ones have different glass eyes.

YEAR 2

We've been learning about the Titanic and learning how it was so big compared to the ones that came before it.

YEAR 3

We have been learning about the Bronze Age, Stone Age and the Neolithic Age. Bronze is better than stone because it can be made sharper to cut down trees to make a space for farms because that was the most famous job.

YEAR 4

I loved that we learned more about History and I loved learning about Boudicca and Julius Caesar.

YEAR 5

We have been learning about the Anglo-Saxons. They came from Denmark and Germany and came because, where they came from, they didn't have enough farming space. They were mainly farmers not warriors so they came over because they wanted to build farms here.

YEAR 6

We have been learning about rationing and the Blitz. I have learned about how they had to ration food in World War II and twothirds of the food supply came from overseas so they had to ration food because while it was coming over, it was coming over on boats and they could be bombed.

You will notice that we have made some changes to our newsletter over this half term and also this week. We have tried to provide you with a range of information about what the children have been learning, other events happening in school and also different events link to our church and local community. This week, we have also adjusted our diary dates section which will hopefully help make things easier to see what is coming up over the coming weeks and in the future.

We are really looking forward to our last week of learning in our first half term. We have been so very impressed with the way that the children have started the year and cannot wait to see where there learning takes them next half term.
