
Good Friday = Painful Day



Artistic Crosses

The cross is the symbol of Christianity because it reminds Christians that Jesus died on the cross and came back to life. People often use art to explore things that are important to them. Here are some ideas that you could try. You could make art in a cross shape or another shape that is important to you and your family, like a crescent moon, a Star of David or a heart.



Decorated lolly sticks arranged into a cross shape. You could take a photo, then rearrange the lolly sticks into other shapes and patterns.

A finger-painted cross. Draw a cross shape on a piece of paper, each person in the house chooses a colour, then fill the shape with your fingerprints. You could also do a heart or another shape that's important to

Decorated Crosses from El Salvador

This cross is from El Salvador. It is called the María Gómez cross. María Cristina Gómez was a teacher who was a Christian and who worked hard to support women. The cross was made to show the things that were important in her life.
