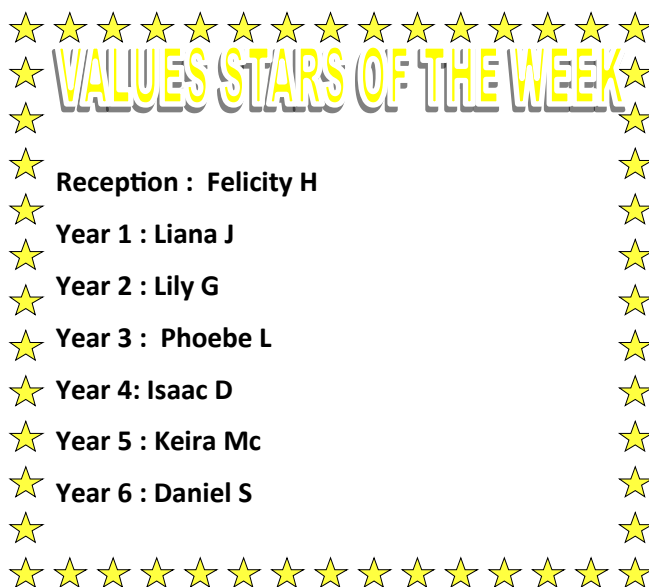
Well done Year 2
