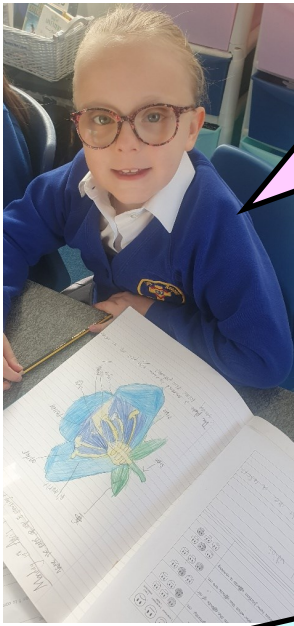
**8th May : SCHOOL CLOSED FOR BANK HOLIDAY**

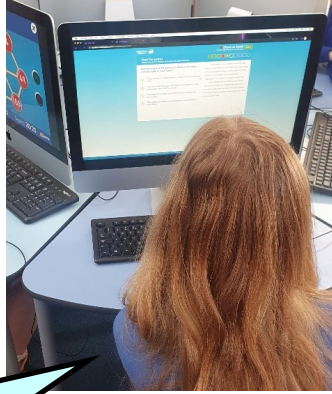
