Book Bags- To be brought in each day, it is also advisable to check these daily for letters and notes home. Each child will be given a reading record which should also stay in the Book Bag and be brought into school daily. A reading meeting will be held for all parents October time to explain more about our Reading systems and policy. We also ask that you put a key ring on the Book bag so that your child can recognise it easily.

Weekly newsletters will be sent via SchoolPING and will also appear on the school website. Our school website is http://www.winwick.eschools.co.uk you can visit this for lots more information.

PE Kits (white t shirt, blue shorts and black pumps/trainers). These will stay on the child's coat peg for the whole half term. Sunhat with neck protector and sunscreen to stay in school (optional). This needs to be in a draw string school bag. As with the Book Bag, we also ask that you put a key ring on the Book bag so that your child can recognise it easily.

Waterproof Jacket & Trousers – The children will have access to the Outdoor Area which is open in all weathers. A waterproof jacket and trousers is recommended to help keep the children stay dry. These can be purchased through Touchline. These are recommended but not compulsory.

Break time snacks-A snack of toast and milk/juice is available to purchase each morning in class. Toast and drink is priced at 50p per day. Children can bring in their own piece of fruit for morning snack if they wish. Milk is free to Under 5's in the afternoon. We encourage healthy eating; your child will be offered a piece of fruit each afternoon. Please see our Healthy Eating Policy on the website.

School Payment information – We use Parentpay for payments within School for School Lunches, Snack, Link Clubs, Trips etc. You will receive your authorisation code and user name the first week of School. We cannot process this until your child officially arrived on Day 1.

Drinks-Your child does need a water bottle in each day filled with water, not juice. Children will be encouraged to drink regularly in class. No soft or fizzy drinks will be needed apart from children having a packed lunch; we only encourage soft drinks in packed lunch boxes.

School meals-Meals provided by the school canteen will be free as part of the government Universal Free School Meals initiative. The teacher will help your child to choose something for lunch each day if they are to have one. Packed lunches can still be brought in if you wish, in a small, named box or bag easily opened by the child. This must contain a healthy lunch with no fizzy drinks or chocolate/ sweets.

Breakfast Club and After School Club- Please see separate information about these within your pack.

Warrington Guardian Class Photo- During the second week of October the Warrington Guardian will feature class photos of the new reception classes starting in September. If you do not wish for your child to participate please inform School.

Parent Share – In the first few weeks of term, you will be able to register with Parent Share, our online Learning Journey.
