



# School Readiness: Ready, Steady, Go!

## Ready: 0-3 years

**R**elationships – Parents and carers, midwives, health visitors, dentists and doctors surgeries work together to support the development of young children

**E**arly Support – Children centres, early help, family support, children’s centre sessions, speech and language therapy and portage, graduated approach

**A**ges & Stages - 2 year health and development review in partnership with your childcare provider and health visitor

**D**evelopment – Children are supported to develop the prime areas of learning - physical, personal, social and emotional and communication and language

**Y**ou - Children develop a sense of self, their likes and dislikes and a sense of belonging.

## Steady: 3-4 years

**S**elf-care – Children start to develop self-care skills like putting coat on/taking off, drinking from an open cup

**T**oileting – Children can use the toilet and are dry during the day

**E**ducation – Funded childcare for all 3 and 4 year olds living in Warrington

**A**dults - Make a difference by interacting, listening and talking with children

**D**evelopment – Children are supported across the prime areas of learning - physical, personal, social and emotional and communication and language – and the specific areas of learning - literacy and numeracy.

**Y**ou – Children start to develop their independence and self-confidence and learn to manage feelings and behaviours.

## Go: 4-5 years (Reception School)

**G**oing to School – Good transition plans are in place for children as they move from nursery to school

**O**nwards and upwards – High Aspirations for all children in the early years.
