



## Parental feedback information 2016-2017

### Things we have improved on...

- New layout of the Pupil Report has been positively received with many of you commenting on the personalised comments from the Headteacher, the child's photo on the front and the coverage of the curriculum for reading, writing and maths, so you know what your child has covered and what they still need to work on.
- Parents were pleased with the After School Clubs which have been put on for next academic year and the variety of the offer. It was also commented on that it was great to know in advance what will be on offer throughout the year.
- Good organisation of events and calendar dates for the whole of the term and for the parental workshops that are being put on.
- Security and continuity of leadership moving forward.

### Things we can do better.....

Comments	Response
PING app not working on a Windows phone	Our office staff are looking into this and are streamlining how parents receive information as we currently have calendars on the school website, as well as PING. They are also speaking to the programme makers to see if there is anyway of linking the app to the different devices parents may have. We will continue sending information out via school PING but information will also be uploaded to our school website weekly so all can access this way too.
Merit, Value and Headteacher awards aren't always distributed fairly across the year	All teaching staff will keep a record of all children who receive each award weekly. This will be monitored next academic year by Senior Leaders within school.
What are the highlighted sections on the pupil reports?	These are the elements within the coverage which the children still need to work on, as this has stopped them achieving at Age Related or Greater Depth.

<p>Concern over % of boys who did not achieve the phonics screening test this academic year</p>	<p>Measures have been put in place by Senior Leaders with a change of Year 1 teacher for next academic year. The current Year 2 cohort will have significant support through targeted group and 1:1 phonic teaching and learning. Senior Leaders have also ensured outstanding teaching and learning for the whole class with the Deputy Headteacher teaching in Year 2.</p> <p>CPD has also been brought in for all teachers and teaching assistants by expert consultants in phonics.</p>
<p>Homework has been inconsistent across the year</p>	<p>Senior Leaders are re-writing the homework policy and will be monitoring the quality and quantity of homework being sent home in the first half term of the year.</p> <p>Reading books are also being re-banded during the holidays. Reading records and homework books will be monitored every three weeks by Senior Leaders within school.</p>
<p>More sporting competitions please</p>	<p>As you will have seen within the pupil report pack, which was sent out, there was an extensive after school club offer which covers a variety of sporting opportunities. These will be developed into sporting teams which will go out and represent our school half termly. Keep an eye out on the PE page of our website to see what exciting developments are being made to teaching and learning within PE.</p> <p>We are also starting a new PE award for anyone who represents our school. These will be presented termly.</p> <p>Also, if any child takes part or receives awards for PE outside of school we would like them to bring them in and we will celebrate them in assembly on Friday.</p>
