Year 2 Crosby Hall Residential

Dear Year 2 Parents/Carers,

In light of the recent Government changes to their Coronavirus plan moving to the Delay Phase, they have given guidance that all school trips abroad should be cancelled. Although they have not made any suggestions linked to residentials taking place in this country, as a school we need to make a decision as to whether the Year 2 Crosby Hall residential still goes ahead if schools remain open and guidance does not change.

We have been in contact with Crosby Hall today and they have assured us that they are taking extra precautionary measures and deep cleaning regularly; their usual hygiene standards are excellent from our previous experiences. While the children are at Crosby Hall, we would be the only school at the centre for the duration of the visit. We understand that in the current climate, you may be concerned about sending the children on the residential, which we completely understand.

With this in mind, we would welcome your feedback as to whether you would be happy for your child to attend the Crosby Hall residential. If you have any thoughts on this matter, please email them to <u>winwick primary@warrington.gov.uk</u> by <u>9am on Wednesday 18th March</u>. We will also be speaking to members of school staff regarding their thoughts on the residential going ahead as well.

Following parental/staff consultation and reviewing Government guidance on Wednesday 18th March, we will make a decision as to whether this residential will still go ahead.

With regard to payment should the decision be made to cancel the residential, all payments you have made will be refunded back to you via ParentPay and school will cover the cancellation costs.

We will provide you with further information by the end of the day on Wednesday 18th March.
