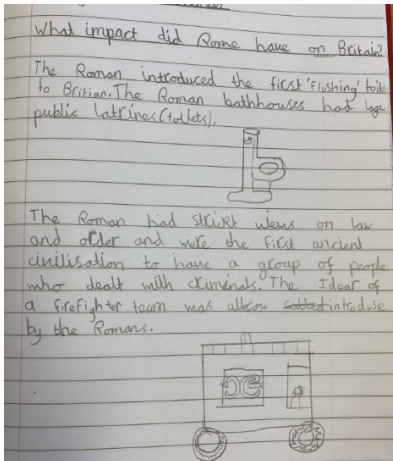

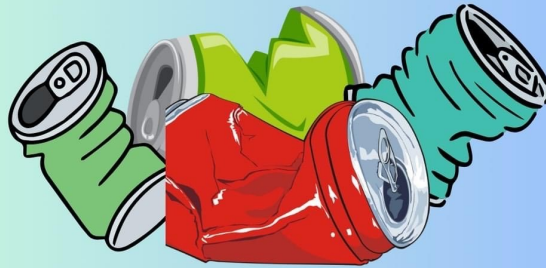
INFORMATION FROM PEW NEWS ABOUT THIS YEAR'S Advent Study Group
