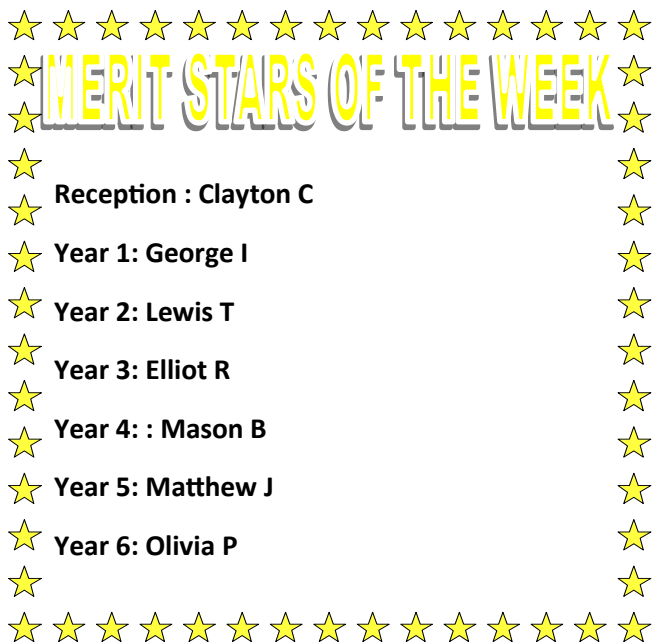
Attendance Star Award
