This week we have had a visit for Rev. Stafford who did his Crazy Science Assembly, where his interests in Religion and Science merged. He shared the story of the Prodigal Son, which was then intertwined with 4 different science experiments - it was very exciting and lots of fun too! We would like to thank Rev. Stafford for taking the time to come along and share this with us.

Our Year 6 children have also had a visitor this week; Magistrate Andrew Emmerson came to speak to the children about his role as a Magistrate, what it entails and gave the children an opportunity to ask questions and learn more about the law, linking to our work on British Values. Here are some of the children's reflections... "I was surprised that Magistrates don't get paid and that they are volunteers." "We found out that you have to be over 10 years old to be prosecuted for a crime." "I found out that the Magistrates can only put people in prison for a maximum of 6 months." "I felt a bit shocked when he said that Magistrates are also called Justices of the Peace. I enjoyed how he explained everything and I found out things I didn't know before and it helped me to understand the law more."
