Home Learning Update

Dear Parents/Carers,

As we enter our second week of home learning, we hope that you are all keeping safe and well. On our school website, you will now find a range of new activities on each class webpage that your children can have a go at this week. Please remember, we understand that these are challenging times and we know that lots of you will also be trying to work from home, as well as trying to support your children with their home learning too. We do not expect you to try and replicate the teaching that goes on in our classrooms; this would be an impossible task and we are not expecting you to do so. Instead, we ask that you try to keep the children in some form of routine, so that when we eventually do come back together, it will not be too difficult for them to readjust. We know that it is important that you spend time together as a family; playing games, watching movies, spending time in the garden if the weather stays warm.

Reading is extremely important; if there is one thing that you try to focus on, it's making sure the children are still reading and we ask that you make sure that this is done as consistently as you can. To support you with this, as a school we have purchased Reading Plus, which is suitable for our children in Year 2 to Year 6. As soon as we have this up and running, we will be contacting individual year groups at a time to give you more information about how you can access this at home. This may take us some time and we will endeavour to set this up as soon as we can.

For children in our Reception and Year 1 classes, we ask that you spend time focusing on your children's Phonics skills and knowledge. Class teachers have provided you with more information on your class webpages and you can also access the free resources on www.phonicsplay.co.uk; a resource that we use regularly in school.

You may also have seen that we have sent out information about an exciting music task that we are asking all children to have a go at if they can. We are asking children to spend some time learning the following song:


