By clicking on the '2Do' tab at the top of the page your child will be able to see what tasks they need to complete along with instructions and how long they have to complete it (See blue picture to left). They then need to click start and complete the homework. It is important that the children then save their work and click hand in so that their teachers can mark it.

Work Work Alerts	 The work tab at the top is where you and your child can look at the work they have completed both in school and at home. This will not however show their '2Do' work until the teacher has closed the activity and moved the work to their folder. The alert tab will alert you and your child when a teacher has commented on a piece of work or has sent it back for you to amend.
