# Costs



The all-inclusive cost of the trip, including transport, meals and all activities is **£209.00**

*(£104.50 if your child is entitled to Free School Meals)*

Payment arrangements are as follows:

- £40 by Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> May - Deposit (£20 if child entitled to Pupil Premium)
- £100 by Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> May - Payment (£50 if child entitled to Pupil Premium)
- £69 – Final Payment (£39.50 if child entitled to Pupil Premium)

*PGL Costs = £168.00 which includes accommodation, bedding, meals (also includes £141.00 discount late availability offer). Transport Costs = £41.00. Total Cost = £209.00.*

*Payments to be made via Arbor – if you would prefer to pay off the total amount in one go, you are welcome to do so. If you require any further support around payments, please contact the school office.*
