Dear Parents/Carers,

On Friday 3rd April, under normal circumstances, we would have be finishing school for two weeks for the Easter holidays.

We know that these past couple of weeks may have been quite challenging and we know that you are doing the best that you can do under the circumstances. Well done to you all and thank you for helping the children keep some form of routine going.

Although school is closed, our staff are working on a rota and will be continuing to make sure that the school can open school over the 'Easter holiday period' for the small number of children of critical workers who need this, with the exception of Good Friday and Easter Monday. If you are a critical worker, and your child is unable to be cared for safely at home, and you are in need of this service, please email winnergowwarrington.gov.uk before 8am each morning that you require care for that day; this will enable us to arrange for suitable staffing cover. Thank you.
