Returning Classes

Just some reminders:

- Please do not congregate prior to you designated drop-off/pick up times, instead trying to arrive as closely to the times as possible and observe all 2m social distancing/once way systems that are in place.
- Please make sure your child has everything they need and that they are ready to come straight into the building to help minimise any waiting time at the drop-off points.
- If you have a message regarding your child, please email this through to the school office prior to your child coming into school so that we can pass the message on to the appropriate member of staff; unfortunately, staff will not be able to speak with you at hand-over times.

Your co-operation with this is much appreciated.

Home Learning

For all children who are still learning from home, we will continue to provide regular learning activities on class webpages, along with access to TTRockstars, SumDog, Purple Mash, Reading Plus (Y2-6), Evidence Me (Rec). Please try to make sure that there is a routine in place for the day with chunked learning and regular breaks for exercise. We will continue to turn on the website learning on a Sunday evening, upload our Monday Worships with Mrs Dymond and email/ PING out the school newsletter on a Friday. Last week, we started to celebrate all Pupil Achievements again for those pupils in school as well as those pupils who are sending work in for us to see. We have also been individually PINGing out award certificates linked to Reading Plus for those children who have been flagged up by Reading Plus as reaching a key achievement point. Who will achieve the awards this week?

Wider School Reopening

As you are aware, we have been waiting for further guidance linked to a wider reopening of other year groups. While we are still awaiting more information from the government next week, we have put in place our proposed plan to enable us to bring back those children from other year groups who indicated they wished to return in our survey.

As long as there are no further changes, our plan will be that the children who have currently returned to school in **Reception**, **Year 1 and Year 6 will attend school until Friday 10th July**; they will then continue to learn from home for the final 2 weeks of the term. This will then enable us to welcome back those returning children in **Years 2, 3, 4 and 5 from Monday 13th July until Wednesday 22nd July**. School will continue to be open for children in the Key Worker POD until 2pm on Friday 24th July, when school will close to **all** children for the summer.

Further details will follow next week, with POD allocations, staffing, staggered drop off/pick-up times and entrance and exit details for individual returning Y2, Y3, Y4, Y5 PODs. This information, along with photographs will appear on the website under the school reopening section.

We also would like to remind all our children and families that, although we can't all be together in person, school are still here if you need us for help and support.
