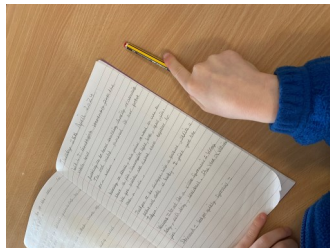
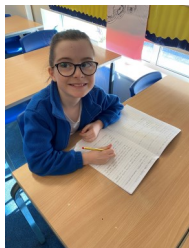


Friday 26th April 2024
