What is early help? Our early help teams work with families to provide support to children, young people and their families as soon as difficulties start to emerge.

Early help can:

- provide support as soon as a problem emerges
- help prevent further problems from arising
- be offered to the whole family with services delivered jointly

Any professional working with your family, such as schools, health services and voluntary sector organisations, can offer early help services as soon as they can see that advice, support and/or intervention may be needed.
